


- DMs will be updating Practice Type in the Details tab

  - General Practicing Clinic
    - Basic vet clinic, no board certified DVMs (GP Only)
  - Hybrid
    - Very large hospitals that offer general practice, but with Emergency and Specialty in the same building. Generally have Surgeons or Critical Care Specialists (GP and Specialty Services)
  - Specialty Clinic
    - Focus only on referrals from general practice clinics (Referrals only)



### Practice Type Cheat Sheet







Practice Type	Description
General Practicing Clinic	Basic vet clinic, no board certified DVMs
Hybrid	Very large hospitals that offer general practice, but with Emergency and Specialty in the same building. Generally, have Surgeons or Critical Care Specialists.
Specialty Focus	Focus only on referrals from general practice clinics
